HEALTH (DRUGS AND POISONS) REGULATION 1996

subject to the following conditions:-

1. The approval holder must only allow adult employees to possess and destroy the medicines and poisons under this approval where the employee is acting within scope of their employment. Further, the approval holder must be satisfied such employees are a suitable person¹ to carry out those functions and they have made enquiries about the person's criminal history.
2. That appropriate security measures are in place, including storage and monitoring, to prevent unauthorised access to the medicines and poisons.
3. That the approval holder forwards immediately, either electronically² or by post³ to the Drugs and Poisons Policy and Regulation Unit, the following information:
 - Details relating to any suspected or known theft or diversion of any of the medicines/poisons.


