Audit history

The biosecurity activities to be undertaken under this AA are identical to biosecurity activities undertaken under an approval given under section 46A of the *Quarantine Act 1908*. I am aware that you have previously failed audits conducted under the *Quarantine Act 1908*.

Under section 436 of the *Biosecurity Act 2015*, the Director of Biosecurity may require audits to be carried out to determine whether a biosecurity industry participant is acting in accordance with, or complying with any requirements or conditions in, an AA that covers the biosecurity industry participant.

This AA will be audited at the probationary audit rate as outlined in the *AA General Policies* available at agriculture.gov.au/import/arrival/arrangements/general-policies until you have successfully completed the probationary period.
